

Terms & Conditions for Golf Days at East Berkshire Gold Club 2008

1. The golf course at **East Berkshire Golf Club** is not for beginners. Guests who cannot play to a competent standard will not enjoy the day and may also spoil the golf for others in your party. We do expect that all your players can play to a reasonable standard and will not hold up play. Each player must have his/her own set of golf clubs, proper golf footwear and is expected to know and carry out the normal etiquette of golf.

2. Confirmation

The organiser **MUST** confirm to the club precise numbers at **LEAST THREE DAYS** prior to the date of the event. These are the numbers that will be invoiced to you (unless we have mutually agreed to an increase) The club cannot guarantee to accommodate more players than originally booked.

3. Non-refundable deposits/cancellations

A non-refundable deposit request of **£100.00** is required to confirm your booking and your cheque should be returned with the signed booking form. A receipted VAT invoice will be issued if requested. The deposit must be received no later than the date shown on our request and if not received, the Club reserves the right to release the booking without notice. The deposit is non-refundable.

4. Cancellation by East Berkshire Golf Club

The Club reserves the right to cancel or amend any reservations.

a) If the Club or any part of it is closed due to fire, natural disaster, employee dispute, alteration, demolition, decoration or by order of any public authority.

b) If the Client becomes insolvent or enters into liquidation or receivership.

c) If the reservation is potentially detrimental to the reputation of the Club.

d) If inclement weather causes the cancellation of a golf event, the Club will refund any deposit made but will have no further liability to the Client.

No reductions can be made if inclement weather, including frost and frozen conditions affects your golf day in any way.

5. Mobile phones

May not be used in the clubhouse, or at anytime on the golf course except in the case of an emergency.

6. Amateur status

The Club only allows hole-in-one prizes when the value of the prize does not exceed the maximum amount that an amateur may win as stated by the R & A unless the prize is being donated to a recognised charity.

7. Advertising/Signs

The fixing of signs, displays and posters to walls upon the golf course or in any other location within the grounds of East Berkshire Golf Club, may not be carried out without the prior authorisation of the Club.

8. Soft spikes

The Club does not recommend the wearing of soft spikes, and players do so at their own risk.

9. Timings

Your reserved tee times and meal times are pre-arranged and therefore it is essential that these are strictly adhered to. You will be notified of your timings in the final confirmation of booking.

10. Damage

The Client in accepting these Terms and Conditions assumes responsibility for any and all damages caused by him/her or any member of the party, whether in rooms reserved or in any part of the clubhouse or grounds.

11. Dress code

In order to avoid possible embarrassment, please ensure that all members in your party are aware of the Clubs' golf course dress code. The wearing of a jacket and necktie is expected in the dining room for evening meals. Clean golf clothing may only be worn in the clubhouse.

12. Payment

The Club will accept payment by cash or cheque only. Credit and Debit card facilities are **NOT** available.

The receipt of a deposit and/or signed booking form is taken as confirmation that you have received details of the Club's Terms and Conditions and that you agree to abide by them.
